Youth Guidelines

Attendance Policy

Your child is expected to be prompt for practices, sporting events, fundraising events, or any other scheduled event that your child is required to be in attendance for. In the event that your child is not going to be able to make the scheduled practice, please make an effort to notify the coach.

Parents are encouraged to have an active part of their child's development by accompanying youths to practices, fundraising events, sporting programs, and other events sponsored by G.A.R.Y.

Conduct and Attitude

It is important that your child have the proper conduct and attitude towards the staff, teammates, coaches, parents, and any other authority figure in place. Failure to maintain the proper behavior will result in your child not being able to participate in G.A.R.Y. sponsored activities. Parents will be notified of their child's behavior and if the behavior continues, the youth will be placed into a G.A.R.Y. sponsored behavioral management program at an additional cost to the parent. The child will not be allowed to participate in G.A.R.Y. sponsored events until he/she have completed the course with a satisfactory rating.

Appropriate Dress

Your child will be given a uniform to wear to G.A.R.Y. sponsored events. Both girls and boys are not permitted to wear their shorts, pants, or sweat pants below their waistline(sagging). A continually violation of this policy may cause the child to be placed into the behavioral management program to correct the behavior.

Transportation

Parents are responsible for their child's transportation to and from all practices, fundraising events, and local events.
